BACKGROUND

In some cases, these systems were a trade-off for fire rated assemblies, fire lane access or a number of other items. In addition, some insurance companies were requiring the systems as well as writing policies for the building based upon the fire protection system. This requirement may be a requirement of the Florida Building Code.

POLICY/PROCEDURE

Any future demolition permit application of a fire protection system will need to be accompanied with the following:

1. A letter from the owner or Board approving removal of the system;
2. A letter of approval from the Building Code Official;
3. A letter from the insurance carrier approving removal; and
4. A letter of approval from the Authority Having Jurisdiction.
